The manuscript is mostly well-written and informative. However, I would suggest some changes in the organization of the "introduction" part and the "summary" part such that it would better convey what the authors would like to tell. First, "Fatigue can reduce the capability of the driver to drive safely" should not be in the first sentence of the first paragraph. It would be related to the main idea of the whole paper. In addition, the "summary" part at the end would suggest some policy implications of the research.

Besides these organization issues, I would think this paper is recommended to be published in the journal.

1. This research is not general case. It was focused in Bekasi City, Indonesia. Therefore, the topic of this research should add "A case study in Indonesia"???
2. The keywords didn't cover the topic. Please include some words which related to the topic such as Accident, Motorcycle, Bayesian Network.
3. The objectives of this research are not clear. What is the major aim? Is it to develop the new model for forecasting the accident or to propose a different analysis method or just show the results of the analysis to explore some factors affect the accident?
4. The author didn't show how the whole factors which affect the probability of severity crashes of motorcycles were obtained. Please explain and show which factors obtained from literature reviews or previous research or etc.
5. Please explain and refer more about the sample size. Are the 184 respondents enough for this analysis and conclusion? Is it enough to represent the whole population in this research? Why?
6. Please explain why the Bayesian Network was used to analysis in this research. What are its advantages when compared with the other tools?
7. In page no.6, line no. 29-40, "The accuracy of Model in Table 2 was measured by calculating the Mean Absolute Deviation (MAD). The Calculation the value of MAD, new data were used comprising of 59 respondents who had experienced an crash due to human, road and environment, vehicle factors. The respondents were earned from outside Bekasi City. The result of the model accuracy indicated that the value of MAD was 20.20%, as shown in Table 3." However, in Table 3, it shows only 24 respondents used to calculate the Mean Absolute Deviation (MAD) or model accuracy. Please explain why?
8. Please discus about the accuracy of the model because it is too much deviation (vary 3 – 67%) as shown in Table 3.
