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## ABSTRAK

**Ayu Dianti, 2022. Kemampuan Mahasiswa dalam Menulis Kalimat Sederhana, Majemuk, Kompleks, dan Majemuk-Kompleks dalam Teks Laporan pada Semester IV Program Studi Pendidikan Bahasa Inggris Universitas Pasir Pengaraian**

Penelitian ini bertujuan untuk mengetahui kemampuan mahasiswa Program Studi Pendidikan Bahasa Inggris Universitas Pasir Pengaraian dalam menulis teks laporan dan untuk mengetahui berapa jumlah kalimat sederhana, majemuk, kompleks, dan majemuk-kompleks dalam teks laporan mahasiswa pada semester IV.

Populasi penelitian ini adalah mahasiswa semester empat Program Studi Pendidikan Bahasa Inggris Universitas Pasir Pengaraian, tahun akademik 2021/2022. Peneliti menggunakan teknik *total sampling*. Jumlah sampel dalam penelitian ini yaitu berjumlah 34 mahasiswa. Dalam metodologi penelitian ini, peneliti menggunakan desain kuantitatif deskriptif. Data penelitian ini berasal dari test menulis. Dalam menganalisa data, peneliti menggunakan rubrik penilaian menulis.

Berdasarkan pengumpulan dan menganalisa data, peneliti menemukan bahwa keterampilan mahasiswa dalam menulis teks laporan dalam kategori sedang dengan nilai 69.84. Mahasiswa memiliki dua kriteria dalam kategori baik, yaitu organisasi (15.25) dan kosa kata (15.19), dan dua kriteria dalam kategori sedang, yaitu konten (20.14) dan penggunaan bahasa (15.51), dan satu kriteria dalam kategori sangat rendah, yaitu mekanik (2.75). Dari 34 teks laporan berisi 390 dari total kalimat. Dan mereka terdiri dari 154 kalimat sederhana, 55 kalimat majemuk, 133 kalimat kompleks, dan 48 kalimat majemuk-kompleks. Ini berarti bahwa para siswa lebih banyak menggunakan kalimat sederhana daripada kalimat yang lain dalam menulis teks laporan. Dan kalimat kedua yang lebih banyak digunakan setelah kalimat sederhana adalah kalimat kompleks. Sementara itu, siswa kurang terbiasa menggunakan kalimat majemuk dan kalimat majemuk-kompleks dalam teks laporan.

## ABSTRACT

### **Ayu Dianti, 2022. Students' Skills in Writing Simple, Compound, Complex, and Compound-Complex Sentences in Report Text at Fourth Semester of English Study Program of University of Pasir Pengaraian**

This research wanted to find out how well students at the University of Pasir Pengaraian's English program write report text and how many simple, compound, complex, and compound-complex sentences were in their text during the fourth semester.

The population of this research was students at the fourth semester of English study program University of Pasir Pengaraian, the academic year 2021/2022. The researcher used total sampling technique. The amount of samples was 34 students. The methodology of this research used a descriptive quantitative design. The data of this research were from writing tests. In analyzing the data used a rubric assessment of writing.

Based on collecting the researcher discovered and analyzed the data that the student's skills in writing report text were in the fair category with a score of 69.84. Students had two criteria in the good category, there was an organization (15.25) and vocabulary (15.19), and two criteria in the fair category, there was content (20.14) and language use (15.51), and one criterion in the very poor category, it was mechanic (2.75). From 34 reports text contained 390 total sentences. 154 simple sentences, 55 compound sentences, 133 complex sentences, and 48 compound-complex sentences were included. It mean that the students more used simple sentences rather than others in writing a report text. The second sentences after the simple sentences were complex sentences. Meanwhile, students were less in use of compound sentences and compound-complex sentences in the report text.
