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ABSTRAK

Anisa Fitria Ningsih, 2020 : Gerak-isyarat Yang Ditampilkan Mahasiswa Semester 2 Bahasa Inggris Universitas Pasir Pengaraian Dalam Praktek Berbicara.

Tujuan dari penelitian ini adalah untuk mengetahui jenis-jenis penggunaan gesture oleh mahasiswa semester kedua Program Studi Bahasa Inggris Universitas Pasir Pengaraian dan untuk mengetahui fungsi gesture yang digunakan dalam praktik berbicara mereka. Penelitian ini adalah deskriptif kualitatif. Itu dilakukan di semester kedua Program Studi Bahasa Inggris Universitas Pasir Pengaraian. Populasi adalah mahasiswa semester dua Program Studi Bahasa Inggris Universitas Pasir Pengaraian pada tahun akademik 2019/2020. Sampel berjumlah 14 siswa. Peneliti menggunakan Purposive Sampling untuk mengambil sampel. Instrumen penelitian dalam penelitian ini adalah wawancara dengan siswa dan rekaman video praktik berbicara. Peneliti hanya menganalisis gerakan siswa dalam latihan berbicara video mereka. Klasifikasi teknik gesture menggunakan klasifikasi gesture McNeil (1992). Dari temuan penelitian, ditemukan bahwa siswa menggunakan beberapa gerakan ketika mereka berbicara praktik. Ada beberapa jenis gerakan yang digunakan siswa dalam praktik berbicara: (1) Ikon Isyarat (2) Isyarat Metaforis (3) Isyarat Deitic (4) Isakan Isyarat (5) Isakan Gesture (5) Emblem. Dari temuan penelitian, dapat dilihat bahwa sebagian besar isyarat yang digunakan siswa dalam praktik berbicara adalah isyarat ikonik yaitu isyarat dengan tangan membuat penomoran dengan 13 siswa menggunakan isyarat ikonik, artinya 50%. Dan sebagian besar gerakan yang digunakan siswa adalah gerakan Deictic yaitu gerakan dengan jari telunjuk yang menunjuk ke udara ketika berbicara ada 10 siswa menggunakan gerakan ini, itu berarti 67%. Dan gerakan yang paling mereka gunakan adalah beat gesture, yaitu gesture dengan menggerakkan tangan ada 10 siswa atau 35,71%.

ABSTRACT

Anisa Fitria Ningsih, 2020 : Gesture Performance by Speaking Practice at The Second Semester Students of English Study Program University of Pasir Pengaraian.

The purpose of this research was to find out the kinds of gesture use by the second semester students of English Study Program University of Pasir Pengaraian and to find out the function of used the gesture in their speaking practice. This research is descriptive qualitative. It was conducted at second semester English Study Program University of Pasir Pengaraian. The population was the second semester students of English Study Program University of Pasir Pengaraian in academic year 2019/2020. The samples were 14 students. The researcher used Purposive Sampling to take the samples. The research instrument in this research are interviewed the students and video recording of speaking practice. The researcher only analyzes the students gesture in their video speaking practice. The gesture technique classification used McNeil gesture classification (1992). From the findings of the study, it was found that students used some gestures when they speaking practice. There are the kinds of gestures that the students used in speaking practice: (1) Iconic Gesture (2) Metaphoric Gesture (3) Deictic Gestures (4) Beat Gesture (5) Emblems. From the findings of the study, it can be seen that the most of gesture that student used in speaking practice is iconic gesture that is gesture by hands making numbering with 13 students used iconic gesture, it means 50%. And the most of gesture that students used are Deictic gesture that is gesture by the index finger pointing in the air when speaking there are 10 students used these gesture, it means 67%. And the most gesture that they used is beat gesture, that is gesture by moving the hands there are 10 students or 35,71%.
